2004 OUTLOOK

The Rams will rely on youth in the upcoming 2004 season. Second-year head coach **David Trail** returns only four upperclassmen from last year's 8-24 squad.

Trail brought in a solid recruiting class of 11 players and is confident this young squad make its presence felt in the West Virginia Conference.

A position-by-position breakdown is listed below.

INFIELD

The Rams return only one starter in the infield.

Sophomore **Brooke Small (Herndon, VA/Herndon HS)** will be the starter at first base after batting .232 with 19 hits, four runs scored, and 10 runs batted in.

Freshman **Megan Zahnaw (Berkeley Springs, WV/Berkeley Springs HS)** will get the starting nod at second base.

Zahnaw earned All-Area and All-State honors at nearby Berkeley Springs High School.

Another freshman, **Jo Jo Small (Old Fields, WV/Frankfort HS)**, is slated to start at shortstop.

Small gained All-Area and Team MVP honors at Frankfort High School.

Freshman **Mia Zappacosta (Owings Mills, MD/McDonogh School)** will be the starter at third base.

Zappacosta played on the 2001 MIAA "A" Champions team at the McDonogh School. She also gained Player of the Year honors for Baltimore City/County.

Freshmen **Erin Donovan (Stephens City, VA/Sherando HS)** and **Shannon Leighty (Carneys Point, NJ/Penns Grove HS)**, a member of the SC women's soccer team, will push for playing time in the infield.

OUTFIELD

Junior captain **Jenn Canby (Martinsburg, WV/Martinsburg HS/Wheeling Jesuit)** is the only returning starter in the outfield.

Canby, an Honorable Mention All-WVIAC choice last season, batted .296 with 29 hits, 21 runs scored and 13 runs batted

in. She also added a team-best nine doubles, a triple, and a home run. She was a perfect 15-of-15 in stolen bases. Canby is slated to start in centerfield.

Freshmen **Kelly Carpenter (Waynesboro, PA/Waynesboro Senior HS)** and **Alyssa Rowe (Enhaut, PA/Central Dauphin HS)** will battle for the starting spot in left field.

Carpenter was a Team MVP at Waynesboro Senior High School, while Rowe earned Honorable Mention All-Star honors at Central Dauphin High School.

Freshman **Kelly Hunsecker (Yorktown, VA/York HS)** will battle freshman **Andrea Changuris (Brownsville, MD/Boonsboro HS)** for the starting spot in right field.

Hunsecker, a member of the SC cross country team, was a four-sport standout at York High School.

Changuris was a two-time All-County and All-Area selection at Boonsboro High School.

Freshman **Julie Sherpf (Berkeley Springs, WV/Berkeley Springs HS)** will also push for playing time in the outfield.

Sherpf gained All-Area and All-State honors at Berkeley Springs High School.

CATCHER

Freshman newcomer **Erika Nagy (Damascus, MD/Damascus HS)** will be the starter behind the plate.

Nagy earned Team MVP and All-Met honors from the *Washington Post* last year.

Sherpf could also see action at catcher for the Rams.

PITCHER

A pair of talented sophomores, **Karen Burnette (Yorktown, VA/Tabb HS)** and **Megan Hall (Keysville, VA/Randolph-Henry HS)** will be key figures on the Ram pitching staff.

Burnette, a team captain, led the Rams last year in starts (13) complete games (12) innings pitched (90.2) strikeouts (62) and earned run average (3.47).

Hall led the Ram pitching staff with four wins. She also posted an impressive 31-to-6 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

Zappacosta and Leighty will also vie for playing time at pitcher.
