SENIOR • G-F • 6-3 • 180

THE HEIGHTS SCHOOL/NEW CARROLLTON, MD

**2002-03:** Returning starter at small forward. Team's most experienced player in a starting role.

**2001-02:** Appeared in 27 games with 19 starts. Averaged 7.8 points and 3.6 rebounds. Also added 36 assists, 17 steals, and eight blocks. Scored a career-high 24 points against University of Charleston. Tied career-high with nine boards versus Glenville, while adding 23 points.

**2000-01:** Appeared in 24 games with six starts. Averaged 4.5 points and 2.9 rebounds. Also added 25 assists, seven steals, and two blocks. Scored a season-high nine points on two occasions. Grabbed a career-high nine rebounds against Fairmont State.

**1999-2000:** Appeared in 27 games with 24 starts. Averaged 8.2 points and 3.4 rebounds. Scored a career-high 18 points in win over West Liberty on a 6-of-10 shooting performance, including 3-of-4 from three-point land. Grabbed a career-high eight rebounds in win against East Stroudsburg in the season opener.

**Prior to SC:** A standout at The Heights School in Potomac, Maryland. Averaged 20 points, four rebounds, and two assists as a senior.

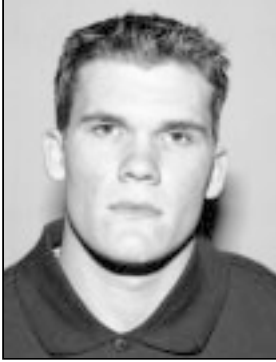

BERKELEY SPRINGS (MERCERSBURG)/BERKELEY SPRINGS, WV

**2002-03:** Returning starter at power forward. Leading returning scorer and rebounder. Strongest and most physical player on the team.

**2001-02:** Started in all 27 games. Averaged 8.1 points and 6.7 rebounds. Also recorded 40 assists, 13 steals, and two blocks. Grabbed a career-high 13 rebounds in season-opener against UDC. Matched career-high with a 20-point effort against Alderson-Broadus on a 9-of-13 shooting effort.

**2000-01:** Appeared in 23 games with five starts. Averaged 4.0 points and 3.4 rebounds. Also recorded 19 steals, 10 assists, and three blocks. Posted career-highs of 20 points and nine rebounds against University of Charleston.

**Prior to SC:** Standout at Berkeley Springs High School. Averaged 18 points and 18 rebounds as a senior for the Indians. Is the all-time leading high school rebounder in West Virginia. NORTH COUNTY (HAGERSTOWN CC)/ GLEN BURNIE, MD

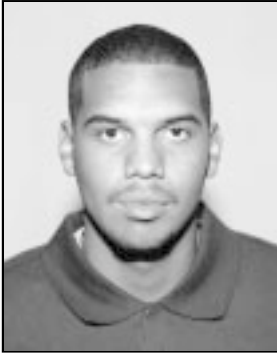

ARCHBISHOP CARROLL/BOWIE, MD

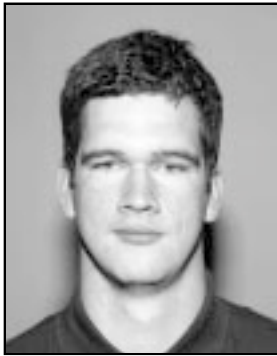
**2002-03:** Will contend for minutes at both forward spots. Talented one-on-one player.
