## **ADMINISTRATIVE REORGANIZATION IN ACADEMIC AFFAIRS**

The Director of the Honors Program presently reports directly to the Vice President for Academic Affairs.

As the Office of Teaching, Learning and Instructional Resources has continued to flourish under first Dean Dwyer and more recently under Dean Renninger, it has become increasingly apparent that the administration of the Honors Program can be enhanced by realigning it as a sub-unit of the office of the Dean.

The Student Government Association, the Classified Employees Council, and the Faculty Senate have all endorsed the proposal to have the Director of the Honors Program Report to the Dean of Teaching, Learning and Instructional Resources.

The following resolution is recommended for adoption by the Board:

**RESOLVED**, That the Shepherd University Board of Governors approves the reorganization in Academic Affairs to make the Dean of Teaching, Learning and Instructional Resources the direct supervisor of the Director of the Honors.
