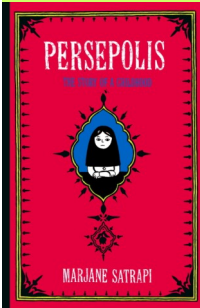

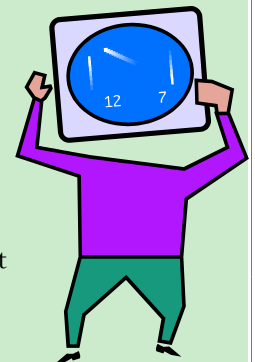
Engaging the Millennial Generation
