The priority deadline for submission of this scholarship application is March 1. Filing the application on or before the priority deadline date does not guarantee an award but will allow for consideration of the application. Applications may continue to be submitted after the March 1 deadline date, but will be considered only if funding is available.

This scholarship application can be used only for undergraduate scholarships that are awarded by the Office of Financial Aid. You must be enrolled as a full-time undergraduate student and be making Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) to be eligible for a scholarship. Unless otherwise noted, the minimum cumulative GPA requirement is 2.5.

Completing a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) every year by March 1 is highly recommended. If financial need is required per the donor's criteria for a particular scholarship, a student will be ineligible if a FAFSA is not completed.

Following is information on other institutional scholarships:

- **New Student Scholarships:** New student scholarships are awarded by the Office of Admissions. All first-time freshmen are eligible to receive an academic scholarship from Shepherd University. The minimum scholarship requirements are a 3.0 cumulative high school G.P.A., a 1,100 SAT (Math + Reading) and/or a 22 ACT. These scholarships range between \$500-\$2,000 for in-state residents and \$3,000-\$5,000 for out-of-state residents.
