Step 1: Basis for Appeal to the Scholarship and Financial Aid Committee:

Step 2: Submit an Academic Plan for Progress (APP):

Step 3: Submit the Student Statement Form, along with supporting documentation:

- Must be submitted on the Student Statement Form for Level 1 or Level 2 Appeal
• Handwritten statements, or statements that are not on the Student Statement Form, will not be accepted
• Explain why you have yet to achieve satisfactory academic progress
• See Examples of Extenuating Circumstances and Supporting Documentation

Step 4: Student Certification: I understand that the Office of Financial Aid will not accept my appeal if it is incomplete or lacks documentation. I am therefore submitting my complete appeal. I certify that all information submitted on this form and all supporting documentation is accurate, true and complete to the best of my knowledge. I understand that any false information may be cause for the denial, reduction, and/or repayment of student financial assistance and may subject me to a fine, imprisonment, or both under provisions of the U.S. Criminal Code.

BE PREPARED TO PAY YOUR BILL. Your bill may be due prior to the decision of this Appeal.

Step 6: You will be notified of the decision of the SFAC. The decision is final. If your appeal is denied, you will not be eligible for any further financial aid until such time that you become compliant with the SAP policy. Neither paying for classes nor sitting out a semester will automatically reinstate your financial aid eligibility.
