XIV. DIVERSITY AND EQUITY COMMITTEE (taken from the Shepherd University Equal Opportunity Policy and Affirmative Action Plan, Revised September 2007)

STRUCTURE

The Diversity and Equity Committee is appointed by the President and consists of members drawn from the administrative staff, faculty, classified employees, and community, and student body. The chair is elected by the committee.

CHARGE

The Diversity and Equity Committee will report to the Administrative Council and is charged along the following lines:

- 1. To review the current hiring practices of the University and recruitment and retention of minority and underrepresented faculty, staff and students;
- To recommend policies and strategies to increase and keep-retain the number of minority and underrepresented administrators, faculty, staff, and students on campus;
- To recommend measures to facilitate a supportive <u>campus</u> environment <u>on campus for all</u> <u>community members</u>;
- 4. To identify off-campus outreach efforts which will significantly impact the lives and opportunities of minorities in the University's service area; and
- 5. The Committee will also serve as a body which will periodically review progress in reaching these objectives and make recommendations for prompt, remedial action.
- 6. Educate the University community on issues of diversity and social justice.
